



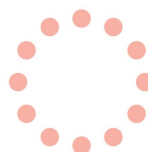

K/1/2 would love to present their version of .....



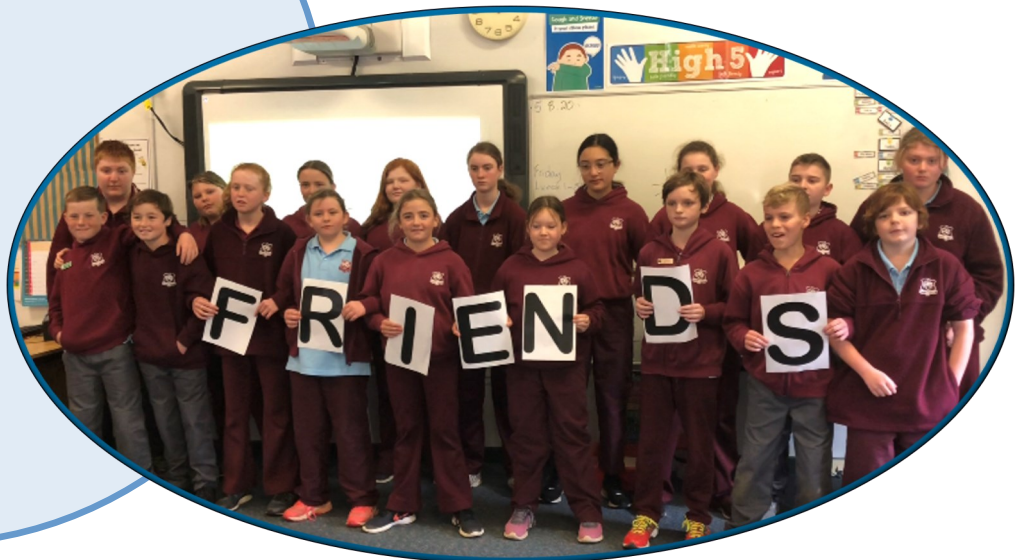
## 2/3/4

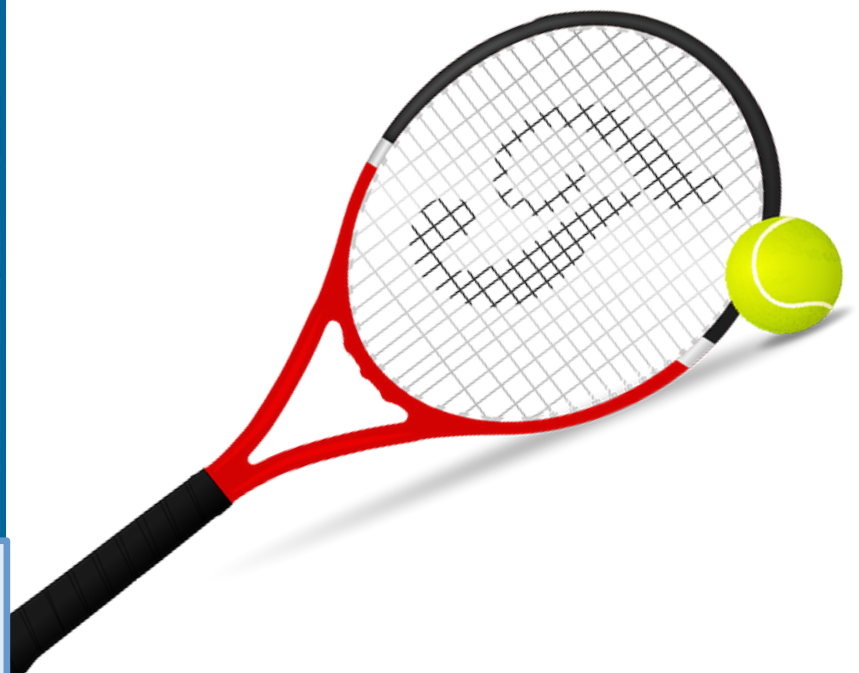
